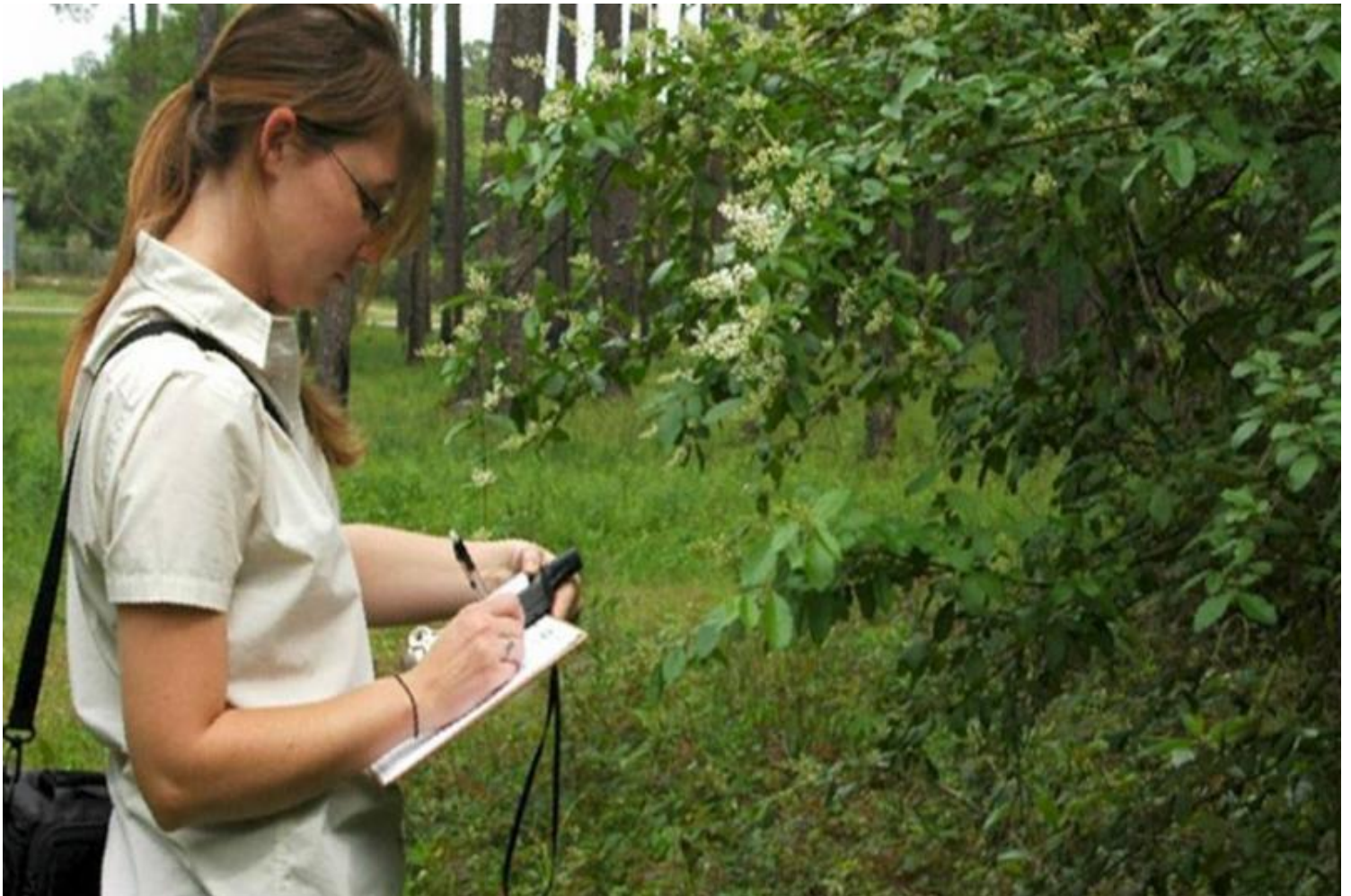

Register for the 2-Day Invasives Workshop on June 21-22 at the UNG Dahlonega Campus

Non-native invasive species are one of the biggest threats to native ecosystems globally. The University of Georgia's Center for Invasive Species and Ecosystem Health is co-sponsoring a two-day advanced invasives workshop with Georgia ForestWatch and the University of North Georgia (UNG) on **June 21-22 at the UNG Dahlonega campus.**

Who Should Attend:

This workshop will provide tools, educational materials, and training for Master Gardeners, Master Naturalists, Citizen Scientists, professionals and other volunteers. The following advanced training and continuing education credits will be offered:

- Master Gardener Adv. Training Credits
- Continuing Forestry Ed Credits: Cat 1-CF 3.5 Hrs and Cat 2 3.5 Hrs
- Forestry Pest App Cert: Cat 23 Commercial 5 Credit Hrs
- Ornamental & Turf Pest App Cert: Cat 24-5 Credit Hrs
- ISA Arborist Credits: 4.5 Hrs
- Utility Arborist Credits: 0.75 Hrs; and Private 1 Credit Hrs

Learn to identify, report and manage invasive species from experts from the University of Georgia, Georgia Forestry Commission, Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Georgia State Parks, and US Fish & Wildlife Service.
